

By the boards command I'm to acq^t you that you are to supply Cap^{tn} Pattison wth what money he shall have occasion for to defray the charges of bringing Y^e gunns away from abt corporacon of Weymouth & those of his Majtys ship <u>Loe</u> now lying in Brickstone Parisish on Y^e west side of the Isle of Wight & he's to deliver you proper receipts to vouch his acct that you may regularly charge the same in Y^e bill of disbursements
