In accordance with your request CDL Form A dated 17th November 1977 chemical analysis has been carried out of a nail removed from the Poop Deck of HMS Victory with the following results:

These results show that the material is of the type known as Admiralty Gunmetal and not Muntz metal as possibly indicated.
