Between *His grace John Duke of Marlborough* Master General of His MAJESTY's Ordnance, and the Principal Officers of the same, on the Behalf of the King's most Excellent MAJESTY on the one Part; And *Richard Dalley Boatwaine* of *his Majesty's Ship Towy* on the other Part; Witnesseth, That the said *Boatwaine* hath received out of His MAJESTY's Stores, within the Office of the Ordnance, *at Portsmouth* *the Powder* hereafter mentioned being for *filling & Discharging the Watch in Harbour*. By Order of the Board *dated 28th July 1718 and Com^d Demand^d 1st April 1719*
