

Malborough Master General of His MAJESTY's Ordnance and the Principal Officers of the Same, on the Behalf of the King's most Excellent MAJESTY on the one Part; And William Hodshon Mas* Gunner of his Majesties Ship the Mary on the other Part; Witnesseth, That the Said Master Gunner hath received out of His MAJESTY's Stores within the Office of the Ordnance, at Portsmouth the powder &c hereafter Mentioned Being for service of the said Ship By Capt Vernon's Demand approved by ComiS* Townsend dated the 17th inst.
