This Indenture made the *twentyeth* day of *Febry* 1696 in the *seventh* year of reign of our sovereign Lord William, by the Grace of God, King of Great Britain, France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith, &c. Between the Fight Honorable *Henry Earle of Romney* Master General of His MAJESTY's Ordnance and the principal Officers of the same, on the behalf of The King's most excellent MAJESTY on the one part; **And** *William Browne* – Master Gunner of His Majesty's Ship the *Kent* on the other part; Witnesseth, That the said Master Gunner hath received into his custody out of His Majesty's stores within the Office of the Ordnance, the Ordnance, Carriages, Powder, Shot, Match Musquets, and other Munition and Habilaments of War hereafter expressed, for the better strengthening and furnishing the said ship, appointed to serve at the seas, in His Majesty's Service by *letter from Y^e Lords of Y^e Admiralty Dated Y^e 17th Day of December 1695*

And the said Master-Gunner doth covenant with said Officers, that at the end of the service, he will re-deliver or cause to be re-delivered back into the said stores, every part and parcel of the said Munition, which shall not be truly expended in the said service with a true and perfect account of the Expenditure of the residue.

Contractions, abbreviations & measurements used in this document:
 Rem = remain: stores remaining on board prior to resupply.
 Supy^d = supplied: stores supplied to the ship from the Ordnance Office.
 Ind = indented – original serviceable supplies still remaining
 Uns = unusable: part of the returned stores that are unserviceable.
 Coll^s = Collars: measure of bandoliers
Cb = Cable – measurement used for rope etc. 600 feet (10 fathoms)
rym = Ream – 500 sheets of paper
 Ells = measurement used for cloth etc. one cubit, the length from elbow to fingertip.
