

Supp = supplied: new stores supplied to from the Ordnance Office. Uns = unusable: part of the returned stores that are unserviceable. Coll^s = Collars: measure of bandoliers qr = Quire, measurement of paper (25 sheets) Qr = Quarter (1 quarter hundredweight Cable – measurement used for rope etc. 600 feet (10 fathoms) Ells = measurement used for cloth etc. one cubit, the length from elbow to fingertip.
