those of the old sort on her next Arrival  
at Portsmouth, together with Carronades  
for her vacant Ports, conformable to the  
new Establishment. You are by the Board's  
direction to cause the said Ship to be  
supplied with 18 Pounder Guns for her  
main deck of the Old Sort in lieu of those  
now on board, and with Carronades for  
her vacant Ports, conformable to the New  
Establishment accordingly.
