

I have am desired by a ???? ^ a Friend of mine, a Neighbour and an honest woman? ... hard to enclose this ire? of Attorney, authorizing you to receive Such Money as is or shall be Due in y^e Office to him he promises upon shall be considered for yor care and trouble ???? there in - & now the better to for yor better ???? government in this Man affair & thinks it necesary to advise you That he has lying some where in Office whether allowed & passed in Dibenture he ???? wether? know not, 2 Bills ^ for worke by him performed ^ the promise be y^e last of June 1708 for 6.18^s.10½ certifyed by me in 7^{ber} 2 1710; the other Bill is for worke done for y^e Unity Hoy & its Boate & entered y^e 28 March 1711 am^t to 2^f 06 00¼ w^{ch} he beggs you will please to give your self to trouble of searching after and to forward this Bill now enclosed that it may receive the Surveyo^r Gen^{II} allowance, who I heare is returned to y^e Tower and settles y^e recovery of to Business. God Graunt him it may not be a prejudice to ^ his health of w^{ch} I supposes? you have some you are not wth out ho?ds? as you succeed in M^r Patten's business lett me in? are and what satisfies? and I will doe for you as for my selfe in obteyning satisfacon for your Trouble.
