

This Indenture made the *Twenty Second* day of *July 1714* in the *Thirteenth* year of Reign of our Sovereign Lady ANNE, by the Grace of God, QUEEN of *Great Britain*, *France* and *Ireland*, Defender of the Faith, &c. Between *The Rt Honble John Hill Esqu*

Lieutenant Master General of Her MJESTY's Ordnance and the Principal Officers of the same, on the behalf of Queen's most Excellent MAJESTY on the one part; And John Shyhan Master Gunner of Cowes Castle in the Isle Of Wight on the other part; Witnesseth, That the said Master Gunner hath received out of Her Majesty's stores within the Office of the Ordnance, at Portsmouth The Flagg & Tarr hereafter Mentioned Being for Service Of the Said Castle By Order of The Board Dated 20th 8ber 1713
